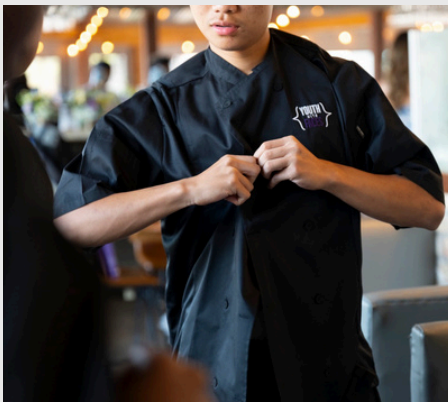

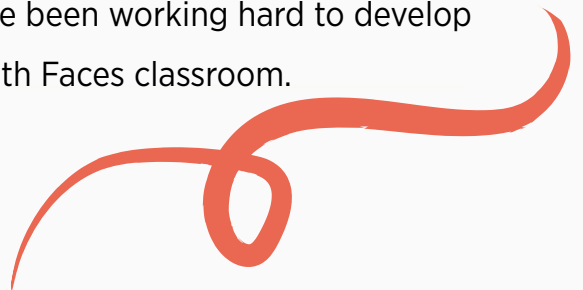
Behind Every Mask is a New Beginning
